Treasurer Report:

- General Account: \$6098 as of February 28th, 2025. (Adjusted amount \$3031.94 with future expenses taken off)
- Gaming Account: \$6369.86 as of February 28th, 2025
- Gaming grant application opens on April 1st, 2025, and must be completed by June 30th, 2025
